A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE REGISTRATION FEES FOR POLLUTION CONTROL OFFICERS' ONLINE TRAININGS AND PROGRAMS ADMINISTERED BY LLDA DURING THE STATE OF PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY DUE TO COVID-19 CRISIS

WHEREAS, the Laguna Lake Development Authority (LLDA) is mandated under Republic Act (RA) No. 4850, as amended, to perform any and all acts, make such rules and regulations and issue such orders and other administrative issuances as may be necessary in the execution and implementation of its functions and the improvement of its services;

WHEREAS, the LLDA Board of Directors issued Board Resolution No. 455, series of 2014, entitled "Institutionalizing the Training and Accreditation of Pollution Control Officers in the Laguna de Bay Region and other Purposes" which provides for the requirements and procedures on the training and accreditation of Pollution Control Officers (PCO) for those establishments located within the Laguna de Bay Region;

WHEREAS, one of the requirements for accreditation as PCO is the attendance to the 40-hours Continuing Environmental Education Program (CEEP) while the 4-hours Continuing Environmental Education Seminar (CEES) is an annual refresher seminar/training for LLDA-accredited PCOs which tackles new regulations and policies issued by the LLDA and other environmental topics;

WHEREAS, to take all precautionary measures to protect the collective health and well-being of LLDA clients and stakeholders against COVID-19, the LLDA issued Memorandum Circular No. 2020-03, directing the postponement of the conduct of monthly CEEP /CEES until further notice;

WHEREAS, as a result of general community quarantine measures limiting the mobility of individuals and clients and the prohibition of mass gatherings like seminars and trainings, there is a need to provide and migrate from the traditional, face-to-face training courses currently offered by LLDA (such as CEEP/CEES) to digital communications, e-learning systems or webinars;

WHEREAS, in the Resolution dated 22 September 2020, the Fees and Charges Committee of the LLDA recommends to the LLDA Board of Directors the registration fees for online trainings and programs offered by LLDA during the State of Public Health Emergency due to COVID-19 crisis;

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the foregoing, the LLDA Board **RESOLVES**, as it hereby **RESOLVED**, to approve the registration fees for pollution control officers' online trainings and programs administered by LLDA during the state of public health emergency due to COVID-19 crisis, to wit:

- a. Registration Fee for the conduct of 40-hours Continuing Environmental Education Program (CEEP) via webinar platform: Five Thousand Pesos (PHP 5,000);

- b. Registration Fee for the conduct of 4-hours Continuing Environmental Education Seminar (CEES) via webinar platform: One Thousand Eight Hundred Pesos (PHP 1,800);

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the LLDA shall follow the same procedure for accreditation of Pollution Control Officers regardless of the manner of conducting its CEEP/CEES (i.e., whether face-to-face or webinar type of trainings).

RESOLVED, FINALLY, that this Resolution shall take effect immediately after its publication in a newspaper of general circulation and registration with the Office of the National Administrative Registrar.
