**NWRB RESOLUTION No. 05-0320**  
**EXTENSION OF VALIDITY OF CONDITIONAL WATER PERMIT**  
**IN LIGHT OF THE ENHANCED COMMUNITY QUARANTINE**

The **NATIONAL WATER RESOURCES BOARD** (“the Board”), a government institution, created and existing under Philippines, with office address at 8<sup>th</sup> Floor, NIA Building, EDSA, Quezon City, states:

At the referendum of the Board Members of the National Water Resources Board on March 19, 2020, the following resolution was approved and confirmed, to wit:

**WHEREAS**, the country has been plagued with the outbreak of the Novel Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) that has posed a threat to the lives of the Filipino people and the Philippine economy as well;

**WHEREAS**, on March 9, 2020, President Rodrigo Duterte issued Proclamation No. 922, declaring the country under a state of public health emergency;

**WHEREAS**, to mitigate the spread of COVID-19, a Memorandum Circular was issued by the Executive Secretary on March 16, 2020, by order of President Duterte, which provides for the Enhanced Community Quarantine over Luzon from March 17 to April 13, 2020;

**WHEREAS**, office work and classes have been suspended and most businesses have been ordered closed by the government in line with the quarantine placed over the whole of Luzon;


**WHEREAS**, on March 17, 2020, President Duterte issued Proclamation No, 929, declaring the Philippines under a state of calamity for a tentative period of six months;

**WHEREAS**, there are Conditional Water Permits that are on their last extension and will be expiring from March 15 to June 30, 2020;

**WHEREAS**, amidst the foregoing circumstances, an extension of time should be provided for expiring Conditional Water Permits;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED**, that all Conditional Water Permit/s due to expire on March 15 to June 30, 2020, including those with granted extensions, shall continue to be valid six (6) months after its/their expiration/s.


