CPA Administrative Order No. 05 Series of 2020

TO: ALL CONCERNED

SUBJECT: AMENDMENT TO SECTION 6, ARTICLE IV OF CPA A.O. NO. 02-98 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING PILOTAGE SERVICES, THE CONDUCT OF PILOTS, AND PILOTAGE IN THE PORT OF CEBU

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 7, 9, and 21 of R.A. 7621, otherwise known as the Charter of the Cebu Port Authority and the Board Resolution No 848-2020 dated 03 December 2020 of the Cebu Port Commission adopted during the 181st Regular Board Meeting, the following amendment is hereby prescribed for compliance by all concerned:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT OF SECTION 6, ARTICLE IV of AO 02-98

The provision of Section 6, Article IV of AO 02-98 shall be amended to read as follows:

“ARTICLE IV

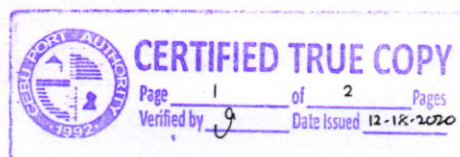
EVALUATION COMMITTEE, CRITERIA FOR EVALUATING QUALIFICATIONS OF PILOT ORGANIZATIONS / PILOTS

XXX

SECTION 6. DISCIPLINARY ACTION AND DISMISSAL - The General Manager of the Authority shall, either at his own initiative or upon complaint under oath of misconduct, negligence, inefficiency, incapacity or violation of the pilotage rules and regulations or refusal to comply with lawful orders of the Authority, order the investigation of an erring pilot, by the Evaluation Committee.

The record of the proceedings of the Evaluation Committee, together with the report/recommendations, shall be forwarded to the General

Manager who may thereby reprimand, suspend or cancel the accreditation of the respondent pilot organization/pilot or impose such fines as the circumstances of the case may warrant. The decision of the General Manager shall be final unless, within thirty (30) days after its promulgation, an appeal is perfected and filed with the Office of the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners of the Authority, which the latter may modify, confirm or reverse.”

SECTION 2. REPEALING CLAUSE.

Section 6 Article IV of AO 02-98 dated 20 February 1998 is hereby modified accordingly.


SECTION 3. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.

If for any reason any section or part of this Order is declared unconstitutional or invalid by competent judicial authority, the declared invalid section or part thereof shall not affect the other sections or parts which shall remain valid and effective.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY.

This Administrative Order shall take effect fifteen days after two (2) consecutive publications in a newspaper of general circulation and three (3) certified true copies thereof filed with the UP Law Center in accordance with Sections 3 and 4, Chapter 2, Book VII of E.O. 292 otherwise known as the Administrative Code of the Philippines.
