SUBJECT : **Clarification on the Application Fee of Department of Health – License to Operate (DOH-LTO) and Department of Health – Permit to Construct (DOH-PTC) of Ancillary Services of Primary Care Facilities**

This is to clarify Section X.B of Administrative Order No. 2020-0047 titled “Rules and Regulations Governing the Licensure of Primary Care Facilities in the Philippines”:

“The application fee for DOH-LTO and DOH-PTC for PCF shall be waived until a new schedule of fees is issued by DOH.”

The ancillary services of Primary Care Facilities (PCFs) may be located within or outside the premises of PCFs, and/or have different ownership. Thus, the tables below clarify the payment of application fee for DOH-LTO of ancillary services of PCF:

New ancillary services*:

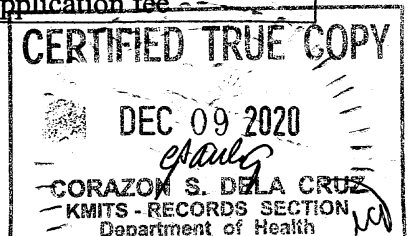

The application fee for DOH-PTC of new ancillary services, if applicable, located outside the premises of a new PCF, regardless of ownership, are not waived.

The application fees for pharmacy and radiological services shall follow the schedule of fees prescribed by the Food and Drug Administration.
