MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR
NUMBER 2020- 085

**SUBJECT : IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES PURSUANT TO
DOTR DEPARTMENT ORDER NO. 2020-006**

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation (DOTr) issued Department Order No. 2018-016 which provided equity subsidy for existing operators with valid Certificates of Public Convenience (CPC) in line with the PUV Modernization Program (PUVMP) in the amount of P 80,000 per unit;

WHEREAS, on 05 June 2020, the DOTr issued Department Order No. 2020-006 which amends Department Order No. 2018-016 to increase the equity subsidy to P 160,000 per unit;

WHEREAS, after a series of consultative meeting with the Development Bank of the Philippines (DBP) and Land Bank of the Philippines (LBP) in line with the processing of loan applications for the PUVMP, in which the equity subsidy shall apply, the Board finds the need to issue the corresponding guidelines to properly implement Department Order No. 2020-006;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing, the Board hereby issues the Implementing Guidelines for Department Order No. 2020-006 as follows:

1. The equity subsidy shall cover all operators who will consolidate under the PUVMP, and shall retroactively include those applications filed from 31 July 2018 until the present. For those who were previously given subsidy under Department Order No. 2018-016, only the additional amount of P80,000 per unit shall be subsequently given.
2. The equity subsidy shall cover only those operators who will secure financial assistance from DBP and LBP under the PUVMP.
3. The equity subsidy shall be given to consolidated operators that have been granted Provisional Authority (PA) or CPC for their OFG-Compliant units.

All issuances inconsistent herewith are hereby superseded and amended accordingly.

This Memorandum Circular shall take effect immediately following its publication in a newspaper of general circulation and filing of three (3) copies hereof with the Office of the National Administrative Register (ONAR) of the UP Law Center.




