MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR

NO.: 2020-090

**PRESCRIBING THE MINIMUM TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS
FOR MEDALYA NG KAPAYAPAAN (PEACE MEDAL)**

1. REFERENCE: Memorandum Circular No. 2019-048 signed by PGEN OSCAR D ALBAYALDE, Chief, PNP dated August 26, 2019, entitled: "Approving and Authorizing Conferment of the PNP Medalya ng Kapayapaan (Peace Medal) to Deserving PNP Personnel, for Inclusion under the Category of Miscellaneous Awards of PNP Circular No. 2006-014."

2. RATIONALE:

This Memorandum Circular (MC) sets forth the minimum technical specifications for Medalya ng Kapayapaan (Peace Medal) to be conferred to Uniformed and Non-Uniformed member of the Philippine National Police (PNP) who satisfy the corresponding requirements.

3. SITUATION:

The PNP Circular No. 2006-014 provides the conferment of appropriate awards to PNP personnel, among others, for specific deeds or significant endeavors. Most often than not, the operational accomplishments are given preferential recognition, without providing equal attention on the significance of the administrative aspect. This situation results in unfair merit system which is counterproductive to the police organization as it adversely affects the morale of personnel, particularly those who contribute in the maintenance of peace and development of our country, a priority agenda of the present Administration.

4. PURPOSE:

To provide and establish the minimum technical specifications for Medalya ng Kapayapaan (Peace Medal) with corresponding ribbon that shall be conferred to Uniformed and Non-Uniformed member of the PNP who satisfy the following requirements:

- a. For outstanding achievements significant to accomplishments in resolving armed conflict, rido, family feud, and other similar conflicts through negotiation or mediation as a) facilitator, b) mediator, c) negotiator that resulted in the settlement of agreement to promote peace or preservation of cultural and gender sensitivity; and

- b. As PNP representative in the implementation of government initiatives pertaining to the programs for Disarmament, Demobilization, and Reintegration (DDR) of rebel forces, as well as programs for Justice, Peace, Reconciliation, and Reparation/Rehabilitation of the victims of armed conflicts advocated and promoted by the United Nations or in an international/national peace negotiating body, council, or task force in the realization or signing of peace agreement between parties in conflict.

5. DEFINITION OF TERMS:

For purposes of this MC, the following terms shall mean:

- a. **Medal** – is a distinctive physical device of metal and ribbon which constitutes the tangible evidence of an award.
- b. **Ribbon** – is a piece of usually multicolored ribbon worn as a military decoration or in place of a medal.
- c. **Technical Specifications** – refer to the physical description of the goods or services as well as the procuring entity's requirements in terms of the functionality, performances and standard designs of the goods to be manufactured or supplied, and/or the services to be rendered.

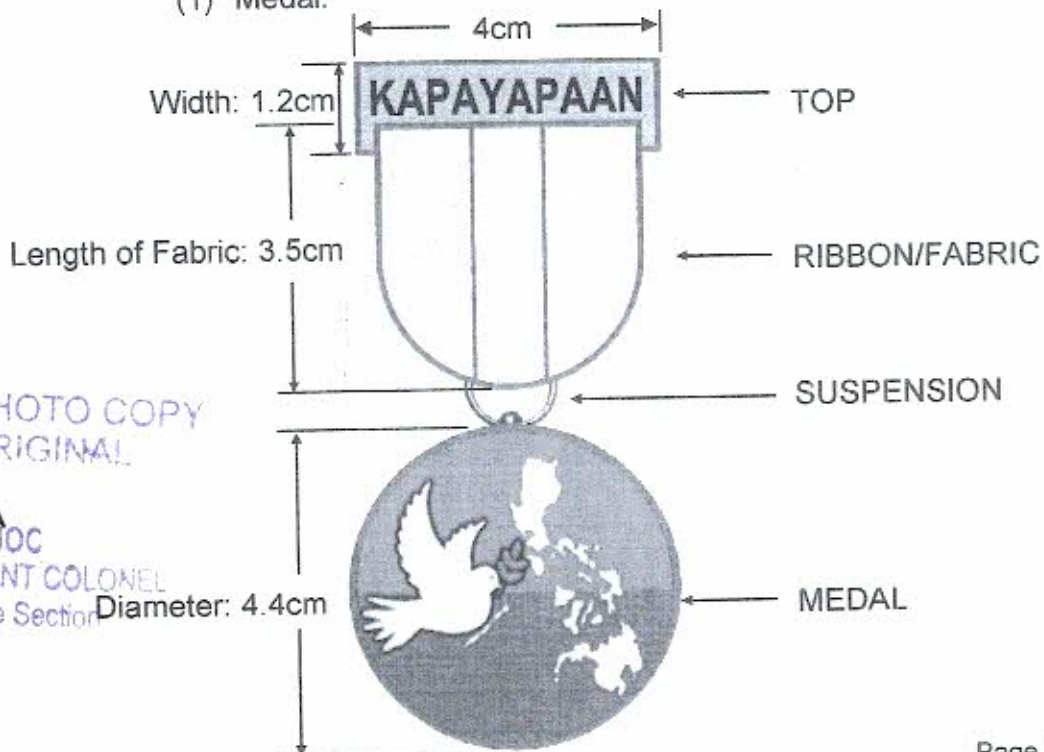

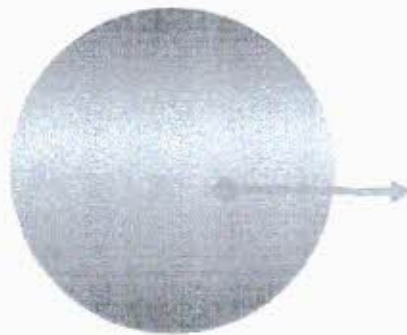

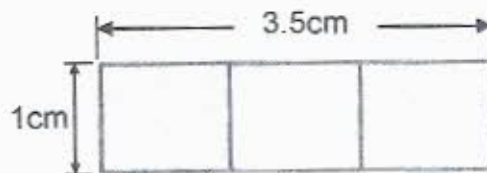
