The said document shall be valid for thirty (30) days and shall be submitted to officials of the Bureau of Immigration (B.I.) at any ports of entry and exit, either in the form of a printed or electronic copy generated by the PRA Web application, together with the passport, PRA I.D. Card and other travel documents everytime a retiree-member/SRRV holder intends to travel in and out of the country. The travel pass is valid only for 30 days from date of issuance. Future travel/s after the 30-day prescribed period necessitates the issuance of a new exit or entry pass to the retiree concerned.

To facilitate the entry/exit and to provide convenience to their travel, SRRV holders are advised to inform the Servicing Division of the P.R.A. via e-mail at entryexit@pra.gov.ph of their intended travel at least seven (7) days before their departure or arrival for the Authority to make the necessary coordination with the airport officials of the Bureau of Immigration.

The Servicing Division of the Resident Retiree Servicing Department (RRSD) shall be responsible for the circularization and implementation of their policy.
