MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 01

TO : ALL CONCERNED

SUBJECT : PROVISIONAL RESUMPTION OF CONCESSIONAIRE OPERATIONS AT CPA PASSENGER TERMINAL BUILDINGS

WHEREAS, the Cebu Province and Cebu City have since been placed under the least restrictive quarantine status beginning July and September 2020, respectively;

WHEREAS, the Omnibus Guidelines on the Implementation of Community Quarantine in the Philippines laid down by the Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases provides:

“SECTION [5] GUIDELINES FOR AREAS PLACED UNDER MODIFIED GENERAL COMMUNITY QUARANTINE. Areas placed under MGCQ shall observe the following protocols:

xxx xxx xxx

8. The road, rail, maritime, and aviation sectors of public transportation shall be allowed to operate at the capacity in accordance with guidelines issued by the DOTr. *Provided*, that in all public transports, a strict one (1) meter distance between passengers shall be observed and appropriate engineering controls shall be in place.”

WHEREAS, In accordance with the IATF and Department of Health protocols, the Department of Transportation (DOTr) has released the guidelines for the Maritime Sector allowing the operation of passenger terminal buildings (PTBs), ships and other passenger vessels up to 50% passenger capacity in areas under General Community Quarantine (GCQ) and Modified General Community Quarantine (MGCQ), provided, that strict physical distancing is observed therein;

WHEREAS, concessionaire operations at the CPA-operated PTBs have ceased operations since 16 March 2020 when the City and Province of Cebu were first
