## NEW ENTRY REGULATIONS TO THE HASHEMITE KINGDOM OF JORDAN

The Jordan government has issued the following guidelines on the latest entry regulations to Jordan, in view of the current COVID-19 pandemic:

- a. A printed negative PCR test (saliva-based or nasopharyngeal swab test), taken within 72 hours prior to arrival to Jordan, should be presented to the airline upon check-in and to the immigration authorities in Jordan. Specifically, the test result (preferably in English) should state the date and time on the conduct of the test;
- b. Prior registration to the link [registration.questlabjo.com](http://registration.questlabjo.com) is required which will include payment for the PCR test that will be conducted upon arrival at Queen Alia Airport. Upon completion of registration and payment, a QR code will be issued which will be presented to the airline upon check-in;
- c. Travel health insurance is mandatory which will cover the period of stay in Jordan. In case of a positive result of the PCR test conducted at the airport in Jordan, the passenger will be notified through email/phone and must do self-quarantine;
- d. Arriving passengers are advised to download the Jordan COVID-19 tracing app "Aman".

In addition, all Philippine passport holders should have a valid visa stamped on their passport which will be issued by the Honorary Consulate of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan in Manila.
