RENEWAL OF THE CERTIFICATE OF ACCREDITATION OF THE
PHILIPPINE INSTITUTE OF CHEMICAL ENGINEERS (PICHE) INC. AS THE
ACCREDITED INTEGRATED PROFESSIONAL ORGANIZATION (AIPO) FOR
CHEMICAL ENGINEERS

WHEREAS, Section 33 of Republic Act No. 9297 otherwise known as “THE CHEMICAL ENGINEERING LAW,” states that:


“Section 33. Membership in the Integrated and Accredited Professional Organization. – There shall be an integrated national organization of chemical engineers duly accredited by the Board and the Commission. A chemical engineer duly registered with the board shall automatically become a member of the accredited organization, and shall receive the benefits appurtenant thereto upon payment of the required fees and dues. Membership in the integrated and accredited national organization shall not be a bar to membership in other associations of chemical engineers.”

WHEREAS, the Professional Regulation Commission (Commission) issued Resolution No. 1089 (s. 2018) or the “Revised Rules on the Accreditation of Professional Organizations and Integrated Professional Organizations”, that provides for the guidelines for accreditation of professional organizations;

WHEREAS, the **PHILIPPINE INSTITUTE OF CHEMICAL ENGINEERS (PICHE) INC.** filed its petition for the renewal of its certificate of accreditation, with the following supporting documents:

1. A duly notarized Petition signed by the authorized representative of the professional organization;
2. Secretary’s Certificate or Board Resolution granting authority to represent the professional organization;
3. Complete list of incumbent officers of the professional organization, including its chapter officers, with photocopies of their PICs;
4. Authenticated copy of the recent Articles of Incorporation and By-Laws;
5. Authenticated copy of the General Information Sheets;
6. Audited financial statement submitted to the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) duly signed by a CPA authorized to practice public accountancy; and
5. Proof of payment of the prescribed processing fee.


WHEREFORE, upon evaluation of the documents submitted, the Board **RESOLVES**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, to approve the petition for the renewal of the Certificate of Accreditation of the **PHILIPPINE INSTITUTE OF CHEMICAL ENGINEERS (PICHE) INC.** as the Accredited Integrated Professional Organization for Chemical Engineers. Pursuant to Resolution No. 1089 (s. 2018), upon granting of the petition, a Resolution shall and is hereby issued which shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation. Accreditation shall take effect immediately upon publication thereof and the Commission shall issue the corresponding Certificate of Accreditation.

FURTHER RESOLVED, to reiterate Rule 7 of Resolution No. 1089 (s. 2018) which provides for the following:

“Section 19. Cancellation or Suspension of Accreditation. - A certificate of accreditation of an APO/AIPO shall be cancelled or suspended by the PRC or by the concerned Board upon approval or concurrence by the PRC, only after due process, on any of the following grounds/causes:

- a. The APO/AIPO ceases to possess any of the qualifications for accreditation;
- b. The APO/AIPO no longer serves the best interest of the profession for which it was accredited;
- c. The APO/AIPO fails to maintain its membership of fifty percent plus one (50% + 1) of those who have been issued their valid and current PICs;
- d. The APO/AIPO commits acts inimical to the interest of its members and to the profession;
- e. The APO/AIPO fails to submit the annual reportorial requirements as stated under Section 16;
- f. The APO/AIPO fails to exercise legitimate obligations required by the Board and/or PRC; and
9. The APO/AIPO fails to comply with the lawful orders of the Board and/or PRC.”
