APPLICATIONS FOR THE 2022 YOUNG LEADERS' PROGRAM ARE NOW ACCEPTED!

The UP College of Law, in cooperation with the Embassy of Japan, is now accepting applications for the <u>2022 Young Leaders' Program</u>.

Interested applicants are required to submit the following documents (both hard and soft copies) for screening:

- 1. Application for Admission (prescribed form)
- 2. Official Transcript or Certified Academic Record of the university the applicant attended
- 3. Recommendation Letter from the Recommending authority
- 4. Two Recommendation Letters from the Employer or from the supervising Professor of the university the applicant last attended (prescribed form)
- 5. Certificate of Health (to be issued by the medical institution designated by the Japanese Embassy)
- 6. A Copy of the Official Diploma or Certificates of Graduation from the University the applicant last attended
- 7. An Essay explaining applicant's future plans after the completion of the YLP
- 8. A Copy of the Applicant's Family Register, Photocopy of Passport or Certificate of the Citizenship (any of these)
- 9. English Proficiency Certificate (TOEFL or other equivalent test score)
- 10. Answers to each of the designated essay questions

All hard copies of documents must be submitted to the Office of Dean while soft copies must be emailed via uplawdean.upd@up.edu.ph on or before 03 December 2021, 12:00 noon.

The Selection Committee will interview applicants and will recommend approval to the Dean who will endorse qualified applicants to the Embassy of Japan.

Applicants are encouraged to manage their time in preparing all documents in case they pass the screening.
