The Administrative Order 2020-0054 dated November 25, 2020 Entitled "*Implementing Guidelines on the Provision of Life Insurance, Accommodation, Transportation, and Meals to Public and Private Health Workers under Republic Act (RA) 11494 otherwise known as the "Bayanihan to Recover as One Act"*" is hereby amended as follows:

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
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

SPECIFIC GUIDELINES</p> <p>B. Provision of benefits</p> <p>1. Life Insurance – The coverage shall be good for one (1) year,</p> <p>a. Public HWs with plantilla positions or hired under contractual status shall be enrolled with Government Service Insurance System (GSIS).</p> <p>b. Private HWs with permanent items shall be enrolled with Social Security System (SSS).</p> <p>c. Public and private HWs hired under Contract of Service or Job Order shall be enrolled to the GSIS Expanded Group Personal Accident Insurance (EGPAI).</p>
